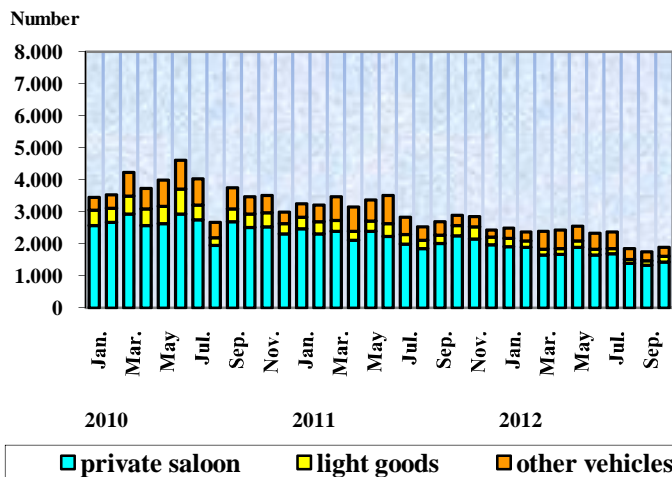
VOLUME INDEX OF MANUFACTURING PRODUCTION
 Trend (2005=100)



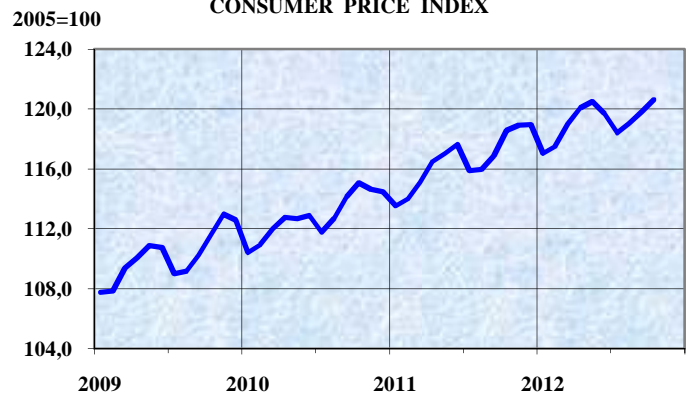
BUILDING PERMITS AUTHORISED
 Trend



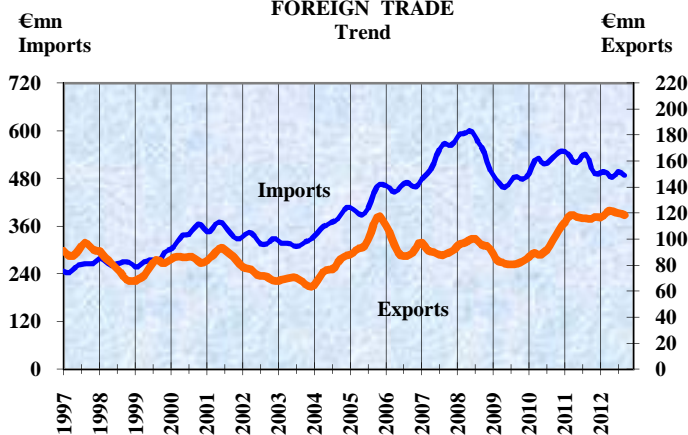
REGISTRATIONS OF MOTOR VEHICLES
